Remote working is here to stay.

Here's how to do it better.

Working from home isn't a new concept with businesses adopting this practice for over 20 years. What is new is the shift of entire departments across multiple industries working offsite permanently. We understand that in these unprecedented times, a significant change means businesses need to pivot and keep employees engaged where they're able to effectively do their job in a remote setting.



Increase the frequency of team meetings and check-ins. Some teams will find it helpful to have a daily check-in. Keep it brief and focussed.



Focus on outcomes instead of activity. It's not possible (or wise) to emphasise hours worked or quantity of activity. Instead, keep your focus on outcomes and measure your team's success through that lens too.



Keep an eye out for people who are showing signs of stress. General anxiety, isolation, pressure with relationships at home, and worry about financial uncertainty are all likely at various times over the coming months. Accommodate people's personal circumstances. Some people will have children or pets in the background, example. This is the new normal, and being patient with interruptions will help everyone work together.



Set more immediate goals where it's feasible – setting out the scope, deadlines and deliverables for each one. Shifting the focus from the long-term to smaller, short-term goals will help people keep a sense of momentum, and also offer you an opportunity to praise them for their work.



Share stories of successes: project milestones, successful meetings, and of course inventive ways of producing great results while working under difficult circumstances.



Be in touch directly with every team member one on one, each day – even just for a few minutes. It can also be helpful to open a conference bridge for your team at a set time every afternoon, allowing them to dial in if they want to chat.
